- Village elections are right around the corner on Tuesday, March 15 - polls are open from noon to 9:00pm on the top floor of the Highland Mills Fire House. All eligible Village of Woodbury residents are designated to vote at the fire house. Be sure to mark the date on your calendar and exercise your democratic right.
- In addition to electing a village mayor and two trustees, there will be three propositions on the ballot: (1) change village elections from March to June, (2) change the term length of village mayor from two to four years, and (3) change the term length of village trustee from two to four years.
- It is with deep regret that the town recently accepted the resignation of Parks Director Gilda Brennan. Gilda has been a mainstay in the parks department for countless years and her service and dedication to our town, especially our local children, will be sorely missed. We all wish her the very best going forward.
- Believe it or not, more snow storms are expected next week.
